



How it Works!

1. Tastes of Rutherglen tickets.

General Admission - This ticket gives you entry into all 17 participating wineries, free tastings of designated wines at wineries, as well as your souvenir Riedel glass to take home.

Designated Driver Ticket - If you are touring the wineries by car and you happen to be the designated driver for the day, you can grab a DD ticket. This ticket gives you entry to the 18 participating wineries along with an official TAC Keep Cup and two tea & coffee vouchers.

2. Bus Tickets

Regional Bus Tickets - These tickets will pick you up from various locations in surrounding towns and bring you to Rutherglen for the day. Once in Rutherglen, you will jump on one of the festival Shuttle Buses for the day and visit wineries. At the completion of the day, you will arrive back at the Festival Hub and your Regional Bus will deliver you safely to your pickup destination. nb - these tickets include Shuttle Bus Tickets but do not include General Admission Tickets or access to the night bus.

Shuttle Bus Tickets - If you are staying in Rutherglen and need a way to get around safely, this is the ticket for you. There are 5 bus routes to choose from, with each route visiting 5 wineries. It is possible to swap routes throughout the day, however it is not recommended due to the time it would take. The Shuttle Bus will collect you from the Festival Hub at the start of the day and deliver you back here at the completion of the day. nb - these tickets do not include General Admission Tickets or access to the night bus.

Night Bus Tickets - These tickets will collect you from the designated pick-up points in Rutherglen, Corowa, or Wahgunyah for the night-time events at each winery. They will drop you back to the pickup point at the end of the night.

3. What's on

Brochure – The festival brochure has all the ins and outs of the day. In the brochure you will find detailed information about each winery, including their menu and wine suggestions, as well as entertainment and extra events.

Website – The website and ticketing platform both have detailed information on each Winery's planned activities for the weekend.

4. Additional FAQ's

1. Do I need to pre-purchase tickets and book additional activities?

Yes please! The whole world has changed recently and now more than ever, we need to know if you're coming! All festival tickets and activities require advance booking through the festival website. Please ensure these are booked nice and early to avoid disappointment.

2. Help! I have purchased my ticket, but I never received them in my emails!

Please email support@ticketebo.com.au with the email used to purchase the tickets and they will re-send them for you.

3. Help! I purchased the wrong tickets/I need to add Shuttle and/or Regional Bus tickets to my order!

Please email support@ticketebo.com.au with the email used to purchase the tickets and they will assist with your enquiry.

4. Can I leave the wine I purchased somewhere so I don't have to carry it around with me?

Absolutely! If you are using the Regional and Shuttle Bus Services, there is a safe, free wine bottle concierge at the Festival Hub. Ask your bus driver about it.

5. Is the festival child friendly?

You betcha, a number of wineries have child-friendly activities and meals throughout the day. Consult the official Festival Brochure for a quick snapshot of wineries with these offers. Children tickets are available through the ticketing platform.

6. Do you offer refunds?

Tastes of Rutherglen tickets are non-refundable; however, they can be on-sold to a friend or family member. If the event is cancelled due to COVID-19 or circumstances outside of our control, tickets will be refunded.
